Programme overview

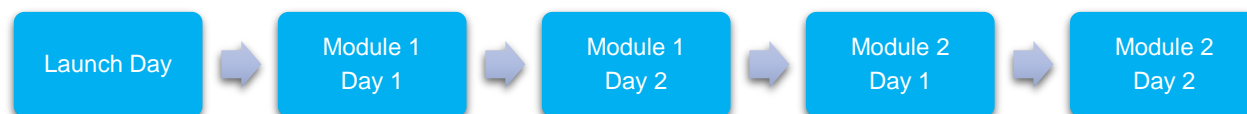
Award

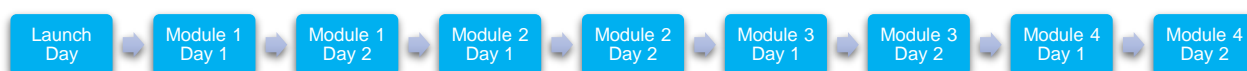
Certificate
